8-9 A - Excellent 90\% or above

- All questions answered completely and with 90-100\% accuracy
- $9 / 10$ work has great detail, while $10 / 10$ work tends to include details beyond the obvious or just correct.
- Most or all of the work is in complete sentences, and longer responses even have transitions.
- Work is neat and readable: demonstrates respect for the grader, who needs to read it quickly \& efficiently.

6-7 B - Proficient $80 \%$ to $89 \%$

- All or nearly all questions answered completely and with 85-90\% accuracy
- Adequately detailed but clearly not as detailed as 8-9 range responses - may lack some specifics
- A noticeable amount of the work is in complete sentences.
- Work is pretty neat and readable: demonstrates respect for the grader, who needs to read it quickly \& efficiently.

4-5 C - Developing but still acceptable $70 \%$ to $79 \%$

- Noticeable questions are incomplete; answers given are 70-85\% accurate
- Clearly superficial with only the most basic answers. Lacks real detail and tends to just summarize or generalize.
- Complete sentences are inconsistent.
- Work seems rushed and lacks as sense of neatness; reflects some disregard for the grader, who needs to read it quickly \& efficiently.

2-3 D - Developing but must improve $60 \%$ to $69 \%$

- Noticeable questions are incomplete; answers given lack accuracy or show lack of understanding.
- Lacks the detail to show real understanding.
- Complete sentences are inconsistent or even missing.
- Work is messy if not unreadable; reflects total disregard for the grader, who needs to read it quickly \& efficiently.
