

BLUE TEAM CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

Expectations	Consequences
Be in your seat at the beginning of the period.	Detentions & Wednesday Schools assigned according to school rules.
Students will abide by the HDHS Policy on Academic Honesty in all team classes. *All students will sign Academic Integrity contract.	Assignment will receive an appropriate penalty at the teacher's discretion, which may include parent conference with student and team & administrative referral.
Absolutely <i>no copying</i> of assignments at any time.	Teacher will take the work from the student & forward it to the appropriate teacher.
Appropriate classroom behavior shall be maintained at all times. For example, no running, throwing things, wrestling, hitting, swearing, card playing, etc.	Detention. Possible parent and administrative contact with repeated offenses and severe violations.
Keep the room clean by cleaning up after yourself.	Individual detention to clean up the room.
Drinks are okay but the student cannot miss class time to buy it and must dispose of properly. <i>No food</i> is permitted in Blue Team classes.	If a student abuses it, this privilege will be revoked for the entire class.
Zero tolerance of intimidation and/or harassment based on ethnicity, sexual orientation, and physical/mental characteristics. Ex. Saying "that's gay" or "that's retarded" will not be tolerated.	Consequences as stated in the student handbook include parent contact and possible out of school suspension. Possible referral to diversity training.
Cell phones and personal media players are not permitted in Blue Team classes.	Parent must retrieve item from office with consequences as outlined in school policy.
Show respect for classmates, teachers, and classroom materials at all times.	Parent contact, detention and office referrals at teacher's discretion.
